Can be a shoelace, ribbon or curtain cord, all are fine!

Large Bag


Medium Bag



NETTING MATERIAL

Recycle net curtains, mosquito netting or voile.






NOTE

These measurements do not have to be exact, it will not matter if the bags are a little larger or smaller (better than wasting material). It is useful to have a variety of sizes. As material is net it has no right or wrong sides


STEP ONE:

Fold material in half and sew side and bottom.




STEP TW0:

Turn inside out and top stitch over that stitching to reinforce. This is your outer shell now.




STEP THREE:

Fold over top about 7cm and stitch about 1cm down from top. Zig zag is easier than straight stitch.



STEP FOUR:

Roll under about half fabric at top and stitch around leaving open about 3cm gap to thread cord through. Remember to back stitch* at the opening.



STEP FIVE:

Thread cord through. Knot ends together so they don't come out.

HELPFUL TIP:

Use a safety pin or similar to help you thread the cord through easily.
