APP15 – Resource Management Marine Pollution Regulations 1998

1. Introduction

- a. The Resource Management (Marine Pollution) Regulations 1998 contain the legislative provisions relating to discharges from vessels and off-shore installations, and should be referred to when any application for the following activities is made. The following regulations are deemed rules in the Regional Coastal Plan provisions - section 68 (8) of the RMA.
- b. No resource consent can be granted relating to a discharge to which regulations 9, 10, 12, 13, 14, and 15 apply.
- c. When considering any dumping or incineration section 138A of the RMA must also be considered.
