APP26 – Description of Freshwater Management Units (FMUs)

FMU	General description
Roding	This FMU encompasses all parts of the Roding catchment located upstream of the Nelson City Council/Tasman District Council regional boundary.
Stoke	This FMU encompasses waterways flowing into the east Waimea Estuary, including Saxton Stream in the south through to Maire Stream in the north. Key waterways include: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Saxton Creek;2. Orphanage Stream;3. Orchard Stream;4. Poorman Valley Stream;5. Arapiki Stream;6. Jenkins Creek; and7. Maire Stream.
Maitahi/Mahitahi/Maitai	This FMU encompasses all waterways flowing into Nelson Haven, and includes the Maitahi/Mahitahi/Maitai River in the south, through to Hillwood Stream in the north. Key waterways include: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Maitahi/Mahitahi/Maitai River and its main tributaries - Brook Stream, Sharland Creek and tributaries, Groom Creek, North and South branches of the Maitahi/Mahitahi/Maitai;2. York Stream;3. Saltwater Creek;4. Oldham Creek;5. Todds Valley Stream; and6. Hillwood Stream and drainage system.
Wakapuaka	This FMU encompasses all waterways located between Glenduan in the south, through to Māori Pā Stream in the north, and includes waterways on Pepin Island/ Mahe-i-puku.

Whangamoā River and its main tributaries – Graham Stream, Collins River, Dencker Creek; 2. Frenchmans Stream; and 3. Waterways flowing into Omokau Bay and Oananga Bay.
