**REQUEST FOR INFORMATION ON PERMANENT SIGNAGE AND MOUNTAIN BIKING EVENT AT EUREKA PARK**

I refer to your request for information dated 6 June 2019 for information on signage at Eureka Park and a second request on the 15 June for information on Mountain bike events within Eureka Park.

The information you requested is outlined below.

The permanent signage is due to be in place by the end of July.

Council staff agreed with the Nelson Mountain Bike Club to phase out mountain bike use of Eureka Park over a period of two years. Council is working with the Club to identify an alternative site for junior mountain biking. The initial action was to signpost and promote against any digging of new or unofficial tracks. Mountain bike events are advertised through the Nelson Mountain Bike Club website: <https://nelsonmtb.club/race/>
