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
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Sketch of "No Spray" area



## VEGETATION CONTROL STANDARD

The following standard is applicable for both chemical and mechanical control (including properties registered on the “No Spray” list) of roadside vegetation

### General

Vegetation and weed control shall include but not be limited to the following areas:

- Traffic islands and medians
- Gravel and grass shoulders
- Water tables/water channels, roadside drains
- Kerb and channel, footpaths
- Around sign posts, marker posts, guard-rails and sight-rails and
- Around culvert, sump inlets and outlets

These areas shall be kept in a **weed-free state at all times**.

Vegetation and weeds shall be controlled along the full length of the property boundary or the area identified by the blue “No Spray” markers. See *Appendix A* for general dimensions of control area.

Particular care shall be taken to achieve total eradication of weeds etc in and around water tables, roadside drains, kerb and channel and culvert inlets/outlets so as to maintain a clear drainage path for storm water runoff.

### Parks and Reserves Areas

The standard for weed control in these areas is very high. The requirement is that any “No Spray” be **kept free from weeds at all times**. If you wish to be included on Parks and Reserves “No Spray” register an officer will visit you on site to discuss the requirements and also the extent of the area for “No Spray”.

### Blue “No Spray” Marker Placement

Markers shall be used to indicate the start and the finish of all the “No Spray” areas or at the major change points, i.e. road intersections, of all properties on the “No Spray” list.

The maximum spacing between markers shall be 50m on urban streets and 100m on rural roads.

All markers shall be placed approximately 1m from the road edge or on the properties fence (Note: the fence line and marker must be clearly visible from the road).

All markers shall be placed between a minimum of 100mm and a maximum of 500mm off the ground.

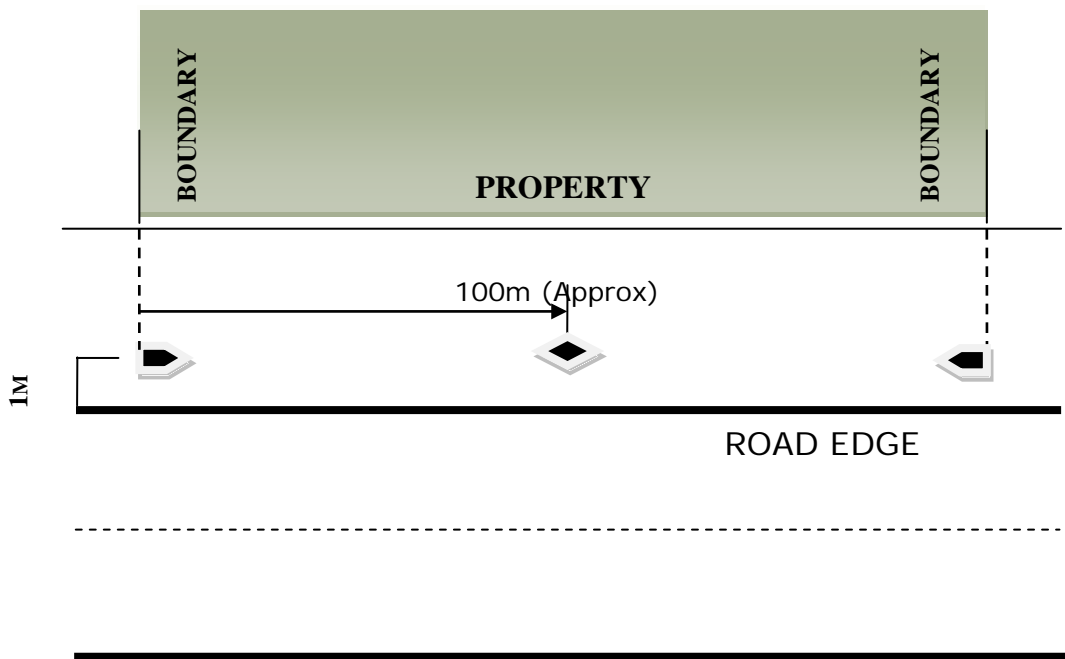
