### **1. Purpose of Report**

- 1.1 This report provides an additional section to the original Mayor's Report (A1157395).

### **2. Brook Valley Holiday Park**

- 2.1 Council's public communications on this matter have signalled that a special consultative procedure seeking public submissions would commence on 28 March 2014. A number of the semi permanent residents at Brook Valley Holiday Park have made requests for significant amounts of information. Councillors have independently sought additional information. I am of the view that the best information possible should inform community feedback on the future of the Brook Valley Holiday Park. To ensure this occurs it is proposed that the matter be referred back to the Community Services Committee to ensure that all relevant information informs the Statement of Proposal. This will provide the opportunity for the Committee to advance its recommendations in a way that responds to all relevant circumstances and information.
