Current licence label not affixed in prescribed manner
Operated an unlicensed motor vehicle
Operated an unregistered motor vehicle
Obscured or indistinguishable licence label
Displayed other than authorised motor vehicle licence
Displayed item likely to be mistaken for licence

Note the warnings are for licences that have been expired for less than 1 month. The cancelled are the numbers of infringements that were cancelled upon appeal.
