Pool Barrier Checklist

The pool area must only contain pool related activities.

My pool area only contains pool related activities. It does not contain any of the following:

- Washing line
- Play area and equipment
- Garage, carport or vehicle access
- Vegetable garden
- Whole back yard

The pool barrier must restrict access to children under five years:

- There is nothing outside the barrier to assist climbing
- There are no gaps in the barrier greater than 100mm
- The barrier is at least 1.2 metres high

Gates:

- A small child could not access or operate the latch
- Open *away* from pool area
- Close automatically after use

Doors and windows:

- A small child could not access or operate the latch
- Doors between a building and pool must either emit an audible warning when opened;
- Or, close automatically after use
- Windows opening to the pool must restrict access to the pool by children

Small heated pools less than 5m²:

- Has sides at least 760mm high right around the outside edge at all points
- There is nothing outside the barrier to assist climbing
- Has a hard lockable safety cover as the barrier

The law requires that all pools are audited every three years, so it is important to ensure you regularly check your pool area to ensure compliance.
