

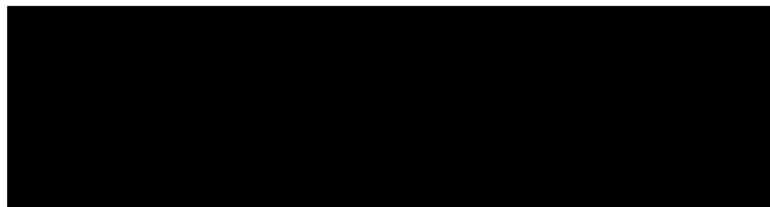

OFFICIAL INFORMATION REQUEST FOR INFORMATION ON CCTV CAMERAS

I refer to your official information request dated 25 June 2024 for information regarding Council operated CCTV cameras. The answers to your questions are provided below:

How many cameras with automatic number plate recognition capability have been installed on roads, streets, intersections, traffic lights, light posts, and other Council property with Nelson City Council's approval in the last five years?

Council has installed two cameras at the Nelson Marina with automatic number plate recognition (ANPR) capability in the last 5 years. No other permissions for ANPR cameras have been granted.

How many cameras with automatic number plate recognition are operating in Nelson City with the Nelson City Council's approval?

Two

Does the Nelson City Council own these cameras, lease these cameras, or are they owned by another company?

They are owned by Network Tasman and Nelson Marina.

For the cameras operating on roads, streets, intersections, traffic lights, light posts, and other Nelson City Council property which are owned by companies rather than Nelson City Council, what are the names and NZBN numbers for those companies.

In addition to the above cameras, the standard traffic cameras across the network are owned by the relevant Road Controlling Authority, Nelson City Council on local roads and NZTA on State Highway. In recent months cameras have been set up as part of a research study for a NZTA road safety project. These have been installed at 6 locations and are owned by Viva City Labs.

Which third parties does Nelson City Council provide data, images, or footage collected with cameras operating on roads, streets, intersections, traffic lights, light posts, and other Nelson City Council property?

Council will provide data images or footage collected to the police on request. Viva City Labs are collecting data from the sensors placed at the 6 intersections mentioned above. The sensors only collect anonymous data and are fully GDPR compliant. Only blurred video ever leaves the sensor during normal operation, meaning no identifiable information (number plates, faces) is able to be seen.

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Does Nelson City Council provide data, images, or footage to Auror Limited, Datacom Group Ltd, vGRID, SaferCities, or Safe City Group Limited?
