OFFICIAL INFORMATION REQUEST REGARDING DATA GATHERING CAMERAS.

I refer to your official information request dated 12 of February 2024 regarding data gathering cameras.

1) Who is installing the cameras?

FOKLK are the research company who have installed the cameras.

2) Who is the data being collected for?

Data is being collected on behalf of Council as part of the "Intersection Safety Improvement" project.

3) Is the data collected in relation to traffic volume?

Yes.

4) Is the data collected in relation to driver behaviour?

Yes.

5) Do the cameras have number plate recognition capability?

No.

6) Do the cameras have facial recognition capability?

No.

7) Will the data be available to the public?

The data won't be available to public. The footage will be analysed by software then will be collated into a report which will guide safety improvements at these roundabouts. Any requests for this data would have to consider the privacy concerns of all people in the footage.

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8) How long will the data be kept on file?

The raw data (video footage) will be securely stored by the contractor and will be deleted after the completion of the project. Data in the form of analysis/reporting (not video footage) will be made available to the council.

9) What data specifically is being collected?

Driver behaviour, volume of traffic and time distribution of traffic.
